FEES SCHEDULE 2011-12

We try to keep our fee structure and invoicing as open as possible by identifying exactly what is included in fees and what are extras and by clearly pricing all extras. Please do not hesitate to contact the Bursary on 01666 880242 if you require further information.

Registration Fee

Payable to reserve a place for your child, subject to the availability of a place and to meeting entry requirements: £50

Deposit

Once a place has been offered, a deposit of £500 is required to confirm that the pupil will be joining Rose Hill Westonbirt. This is refundable once the pupil has left, but only if they have attended for at least one full term. (A deposit of £250 is required for Nursery entrants, with the balance of £250 being paid upon entry to Reception).

School Fees

Nursery: £2,252.25 per term (Sessions charged pro rata) Morning 8.00am – 12 noon = £19.95; Lunchtime 12 noon – 1.00pm inc. hot lunch = £6.04; Afternoon 1.00pm – 4.00pm £14.96. After school 4.00pm – 6.00pm = £9.50.

Reception: £2,140 per term (£6,420 per annum)

Year 1: £2,160 per term (£6,480 per annum)

Year 2: £2,170 per term (£6,510 per annum)

Year 3: £3,170 per term (£9,510 per annum)

Year 4: £3,200 per term (£9,600 per annum)

Year 5: £3,210 per term (£9,630 per annum)

Year 6: £3,225 per term (£9,675 per annum)

Fees are payable in three equal amounts, termly in advance, on or before the first day of each term. Please see our Standard Terms and Conditions on the reverse of our Registration Form. The School Fees cover the normal curriculum and most books and stationery. The following, where applicable, may be charged to a pupil's account: extra subjects, after-school activities, travel, excursions, examinations and medical treatment. Late payment surcharges will be levied on all outstanding accounts not fully paid by the first day of term.

Reductions

Where there are two siblings in the school there is a 5% discount offered on the younger sibling's net school fees (after any reductions for Scholarship, Bursary or other provision). Where there are three siblings simultaneously in the school, there will be a 5% reduction on the second child's net school fees and a 10% reduction offered on the third child's net school fees. However, when the oldest sibling leaves, the sibling 5% reduction will be applied against the younger remaining sibling's net school fees only. A reduction of between 10% and 20% of fees, depending on circumstances, may be granted to serving UK Service Personnel and to members of the UK Diplomatic Services. A reduction of up to 30%, depending on circumstances, is available to the children of the Clergy.

Advance Payment of Fees (Composition Fee Scheme)

The Governors will accept the payment of a lump sum to cover the fees for seven years or any other agreed period. The scheme is quite flexible and if, for example, a parent wishes to deposit a single sum to provide part of the fees, a special quotation will be submitted. Details of the Composition Fee Scheme can be obtained from the Bursary, and quotations to meet individual circumstances will be provided on request.

Voluntary Extras

Musical Instruments & Solo singing £200 (one lesson per week for a term)

Instrument Hire:

Violin, Viola or Guitar £17.50 (per term or part term) .All other instruments £32.50 (per term or part term)

Learning Support £250 (one lesson per week for a term & to include specialist consumables)

Speech & Drama £165 (one lesson per week for a term)

After school care 3.30 – 4.10pm – Reception to Year 2 = Free. Tea optional @ £4.00

After school clubs & prep including tea 4.10 – 6.00pm – Reception – Year 6 = £9.50 per day

Daily School Transport £35.00 (per week, return journey); £20.00 (per week, one-way journey)
